An introduction to comics where you will learn to create your own characters and stories. You will learn to draw facial features and expressions, body shapes, basic poses, muscle formations and body positions, from Manga and Superhero to independent works. You will explore actual characters including princesses, warriors, cool boys and girls, mysterious fantasy characters and awesome robots as a springboard to creating your own unique characters and stories. Limited to 6 participants.

Animate – Animations and Cartoons (aged 16-25)

Beautiful, elegant, dramatic and freaky. Animation, including Japanese anime, Claymation and cartoons have intrigued audiences with their use of stylised facial expressions and body proportions and dramatic storylines in which characters confront psychological and emotional ordeals. You will be taught complex characterisation skills, scripting processes and storyboarding through effective camera angles. The final project will take the form of a short animated cartoon completed in 2D traditional animation style. Limited to 6 participants.
